

Dr. James Reeves Biography...



As founding pastor of Fort Worth's City On A Hill Church in 1984, Dr. James Reeves regularly sees wounded people find hope and restoration through Jesus Christ.

After receiving his B.A. in ancient Greek from Baylor University in 1976, James received his MDiv. and DMin. degrees from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in 1981 and 1988.

James has been a pastor for more than 40 years. Thirtyeight of those years have been in the same church, City On A Hill, founded in 1984. In 1992 the church made a transition and since that time has been known as the "Hospital Church" because of its work of Help, Hope, and Healing, for hurting people, both spiritually and emotionally.

James is no stranger to woundedness. He was born into an alcoholic home and suffered the emotional wounds of a very difficult childhood. Years later the bills began to come due in his life, as the emotional wounds he had glossed over and ignored for years began to surface. James nearly resigned from pastoral ministry, but chose to confront his past, then used his newfound freedom in Christ to build a church based on resolving emotional woundedness issues for greater intimacy with Christ.

James's first book Refuge, How "Hospital Church" ministry can change your church forever, was published by Kregel, Publishers, in 2010. His second work is *Life Change for Every Christian*. James was also one of the presenters in the *Conquer Series For Men*, a video series focused on helping men live pornography free. In 2021 James completed the production and direction of his own video series called the *Fearless Series For Women*. The *Fearless Series* is designed to give Christian women in the church a safe tool to get the discussion started about the plague

of sexual abuse of women, and give on opening for survivors to enter into the healing process. It is being used in churches across America (Website: FS4Women.com). In March 2023, James released the Fearless Series For Men, featuring Max Lucado and Geremy Keeton, Director of Counseling for Focus on the Family. James is a regular speaker at conferences across America about how the local Church can minister effectively to survivors of sexual trauma.

James and his wife, Laura, have two grown children. Their daughter Tiffany, is a Pediatric Trauma Nurse Practitioner and is married to Davis who is a pastor. They have given James and Laura three beautiful grandchildren.

Their son Zack, who is married to Ashley, is a former touring professional golfer and is now in business. Zack and Ashley have two precious children whom "Pops" and "NuNu" adore.
