At Restart Training Center Ministry we understand there are multiple causes when men become addicted to drugs, alcohol, pornography, gambling, etc. Some of the causes include traumatic experiences (e.g., auto accident, physical illness, sports injury, abuse, curiosity, rebellious attitude, etc.). Phase One

- One-on-one, group, marriage, relationship, and family counseling
- Vocational therapy and job readiness support
- Biblical teaching and life-skills classes
- Prison clergy visitation
- Legal support and advocacy
- Transportation to medical and legal appointments
- Volunteer training and development
- Six-month residential recovery program (including meals)

Phase Two

- Renting a room for six months
- Providing evening meals
- Access to a common cooking area
- Recovery support for spiritual, mental, and emotional well-being
- In-house support group
- Safe and secure environment
- Assistance with transportation
- Help with financial management
- Support with employment opportunities

- 12:30 pm – Personal/Free Time
- 1:00 / 1:30 pm – Afternoon Class
- 3:00 / 3:30 pm – Gym & Recreation
- 4:30 pm – Personal/Free Time
- 5:00 pm – Supper
- 5:30 pm – Personal/Free Time

Evenings feature rotating activities such as 12-Step group meetings, group counseling, men's prayer gatherings, and campfire fellowship.

Take the First Step

Step 1: Complete the Intake Form

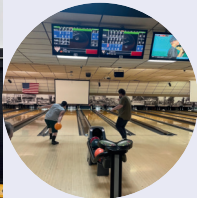
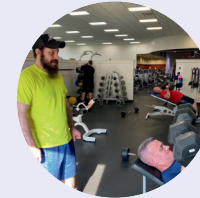
Submit the form online, or print a copy to return by mail, fax, or in person. Applicants must also read and sign the Student Handbook.

Step 2: Phone Interview

A phone interview with the applicant is required for admission into the Residential Program.

Step 3: Evaluation & Invitation

After we receive your intake form, RTCM will schedule a bed date and extend an invitation to begin the program, if it is determined to be the best next step.
